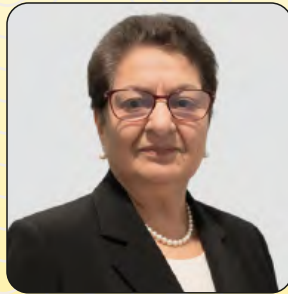

GUIDELINES FOR SCIENTIFIC RESEARCH PAPER PRESENTATION

- Original and unpublished research papers are invited for presentation.
- A soft copy of the abstract should be sent to panchamrutinstituteofnursing@gmail.com before 25/06/2026.
- The Scientific Paper must be prepared in MS Word format using Times New Roman font, size 12, with 1.5 line spacing.
- All supporting evidence related to the study, including the research methodology, plagiarism report, and ethical approval, should be submitted along with the abstract.
- The first page should include the authors' names, designations, institution names, email addresses, and phone numbers.
- If there are more than two authors, details of each author and an undertaking from the authors regarding the presentation must be submitted.
- The minimum word limit for the abstract is 300 words. At least three keywords must be provided, and all keywords should be separated by commas.
- The best three papers will be awarded by the expert panel of judges based on the live presentation.
- The presentation should be prepared in PowerPoint (PPT) format.
- The presentation time is limited to 15 minutes and will be followed by 10–15 minutes of discussion.
